Ms. Kakkar, a resident of India, is a biotechnologist by training with a doctorate in Ecosystem Management from the University of Delhi. During the last 18 years, she has used her experience as an Environment Impact Assessment specialist with the Ministry of Environment and Forests in India to set up an environment department and subsequently shape environmental, energy and sustainability strategies for the Indian steel and mining industries. She led the first LCA study for the steel sector in India and has been actively involved in developing carrying capacity studies in ecologically fragile / biodiversity rich mining areas.
